MURALS

2023 "Prairie Fire" - Location: 166 N. Aberdeen St. Chicago IL

160' wide x 35' high - Budget Total: \$40,000

Summary: *Historically, prairie fires replenished nutrients to the soil encouraging new growth. This ecological fact echoes Chicago's history which owes so much of its identity to the reconstruction that took place after the great fire and the innovation of the steel frame skyscraper. The reference to a stage set and the use of dramatic lighting functions as a nod to Chicago's thriving and dynamic theater scene. It also helps place the wildfire in the context of a drama or metaphor.*

2023 "Around the Corner" - 109 W. Silver Springs Blvd., Ocala FL

50' wide x 20' high - Budget: \$25,000

Summary: *Two very distinct and different kinds of North Florida landscapes, a lush riparian waterway and a dry prairie on the edge of a pineland, meet at the corner of the building in much the same way that these landscapes are juxtaposed in the nearby Ocala National Forest. Dramatic lighting and mysterious elements in each refer to specific aspects of the local environment and the wonder to be found there.*

2021 "The Conversation" - 223 W. Broadway, Frankfort KY

80' wide x 25' high - Budget: \$20,000

Summary: *A drama unfolds in a distinctly Kentucky landscape. Two chairs, one firmly on the ground, the other adrift in a starry sky, are engaged in a kind of dialogue. An imaginary constellation echoes the conversation, jumping from point to point, veering off on tangents and circling back. A ladder leads up to the stage inviting viewers into the scene.*

2021 "Gravity" - 8400 N. Kellogg St., Portland OR

170' wide x 18' high - Budget: \$34,000

Summary: *Originally designed in late 2019, the mural depicts the Columbia Valley interspersed with objects drifting into the air as a metaphor for change and unease in a time of climate and other crises. The imagery took on an interesting post-pandemic interpretation as daily life seemed to become surreal and unmoored.*

2020 "Over the Valley" - Key Financial Center, 702 W. Idaho St., Boise, ID

56' wide x 130' high - Budget total: \$85,000

Summary: *"The river appears as though the viewer is standing above and looking down on it—through a window, perhaps—which creates an almost illusory experience when gazing up at the 11-story mural from the ground level. It is a painting that insists on a second look; viewers must orient themselves to the world in the painting and then re-orient to the world around them, suddenly altered."*

2019 "Wildwood" - Wildwood Academy - 13 Railroad St., Hood River, Oregon

Size: 60' wide x 9' high - Budget total: \$15,000

Summary: *In the school library/common room, one wall is filled with a starry sky over a forest. Around the corner, the forest fills the hallway. Some of the stars descend into it and illuminate the trees. The lights become a metaphor for learning, each one a bit of knowledge revealing not only answers but new mysteries to unravel.*

2018 "Absence & Presence" - The Fowler Apts., 505 W. Broad St. Boise, ID

170' wide x 40' high - Budget total: \$60,000

Summary: *The mural depicts two historic homes which once occupied the building site. The homes were moved to new locations within the city and restored. By painting the sky and allowing the base gray color of the stucco wall to act as a silhouette, the houses become ghostlike, suggesting both their absence as well as their continued presence in the life and history of the city.*

2017 "The Big Backyard" - The Watercooler Apts., 1401 W. Idaho St., Boise ID

50' wide x 40' high - Budget total: \$27,000

Summary: *Boise is surrounded by some of the wildest and most scenic land in the country, but those landscapes are all but invisible among the buildings of downtown Boise. The mural acts as a mental prompt, a reminder of what home entails. The floating chair invites residents to metaphorically sit back and enjoy the view.*

2016 "Constellation" - 825 N. Cook St., Portland OR

80' wide x 25' high - Budget total: \$31,000

Summary: *The mural depicts a northwest landscape under an elaborate constellation representing the network of communities, large and small that make up the region. The chair and telescope invite the individual to witness their own connection to the larger whole.*
