# Lead Artist/Organizer Wood-fire Creative Intensive at Ox-Bow School of Art and Artist's Residency

About the event: The Wood-fire Creative Intensive at Ox-Bow School of Art and Artist's Residency is a bi-annual event that has been in operation since 2007. The event is lead and organized by Israel Davis, Assistant Professor of Sculpture and Functional Art at Kendall College of Art and Design of Ferris State University. Originally established to offer KCAD students and ceramists from the surrounding area access to atmospheric firing processes, this four-day three-night event to load and fire the wood-kiln has evolved into an immersion experience of creativity, community, and learning. Due to the time-intensive nature of wood-firing ceramic art, the process provides an intimate opportunity for shared knowledge and studios inquiry. So, in the fall of 2008 a visiting artist component was added. From then on the event has transformed from a wood-fire workshop to become a "creative intensive" where students and participants engage with visiting artists, witness demonstrations, and work together toward creative goals.
