Circle Time Activities

Gather the children around in a circle for a fun and exciting read of *Babies Around the World: Dancing*. These activities will help the students learn culture, geography, and language.

Ask the children if they like to dance. Do you know of any fancy dance moves? Can you tell me your favorite? Have the kids get up from their seat and show you their favorite dance moves.

Culture

Talk about the different dances that certain countries perform from *Babies Around the World: Dancing.*

India- Bollywood Morocco- Belly Dancing

China- Dragon Dance South Africa- Tribal Dance

Brazil- Samba Ireland- Step Dance

Spain- Flamenco North America- Bison and Grass Dance

Show the children a video of compilation of the above dances from the book. Being interactive will hold the children's attention.



Geography

Next, show the children a World map of the 7 continents. Have them help you identify the country to the continent. Have them place a cut-out dancer on the map to the country/continent they belong to.

Language

Explain to the children that different countries speak different languages. Teach the children how to say the greetings from the book.


India- Namaste (Hindi) Morocco- Marhabaan (Arabic)


China- Ni Hao (Mandarin) South Africa- Hallo (Afrikaans)

Brazil- Óla (Portuguese) Ireland- Día Duit (Irish)


Spain- Hola (Spanish) North America- Hello (English)
