Picasso chose stripes for fashion, not for safety.

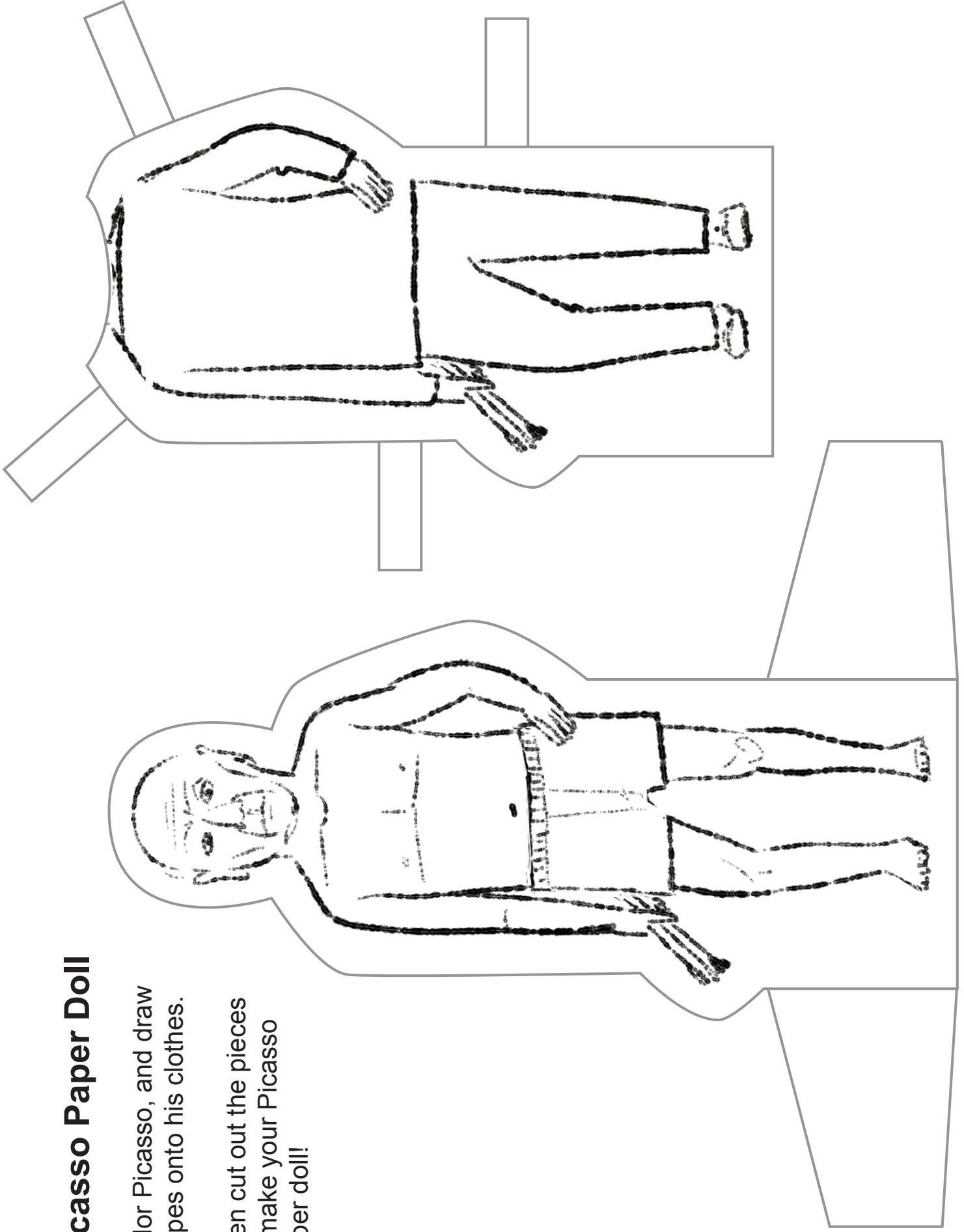
Besides wearing stripes, Picasso often painted bold striped patterns into his art, too.

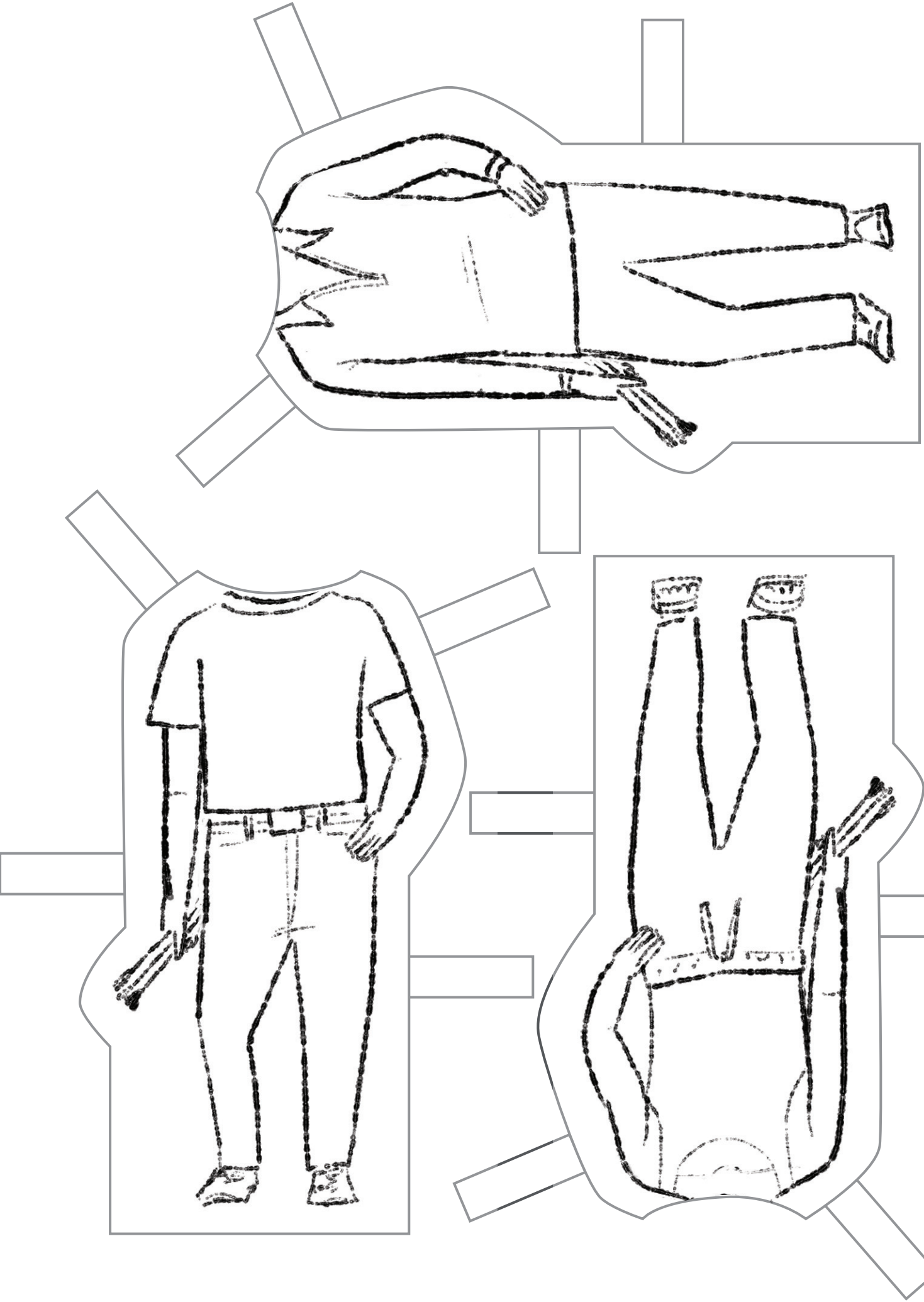


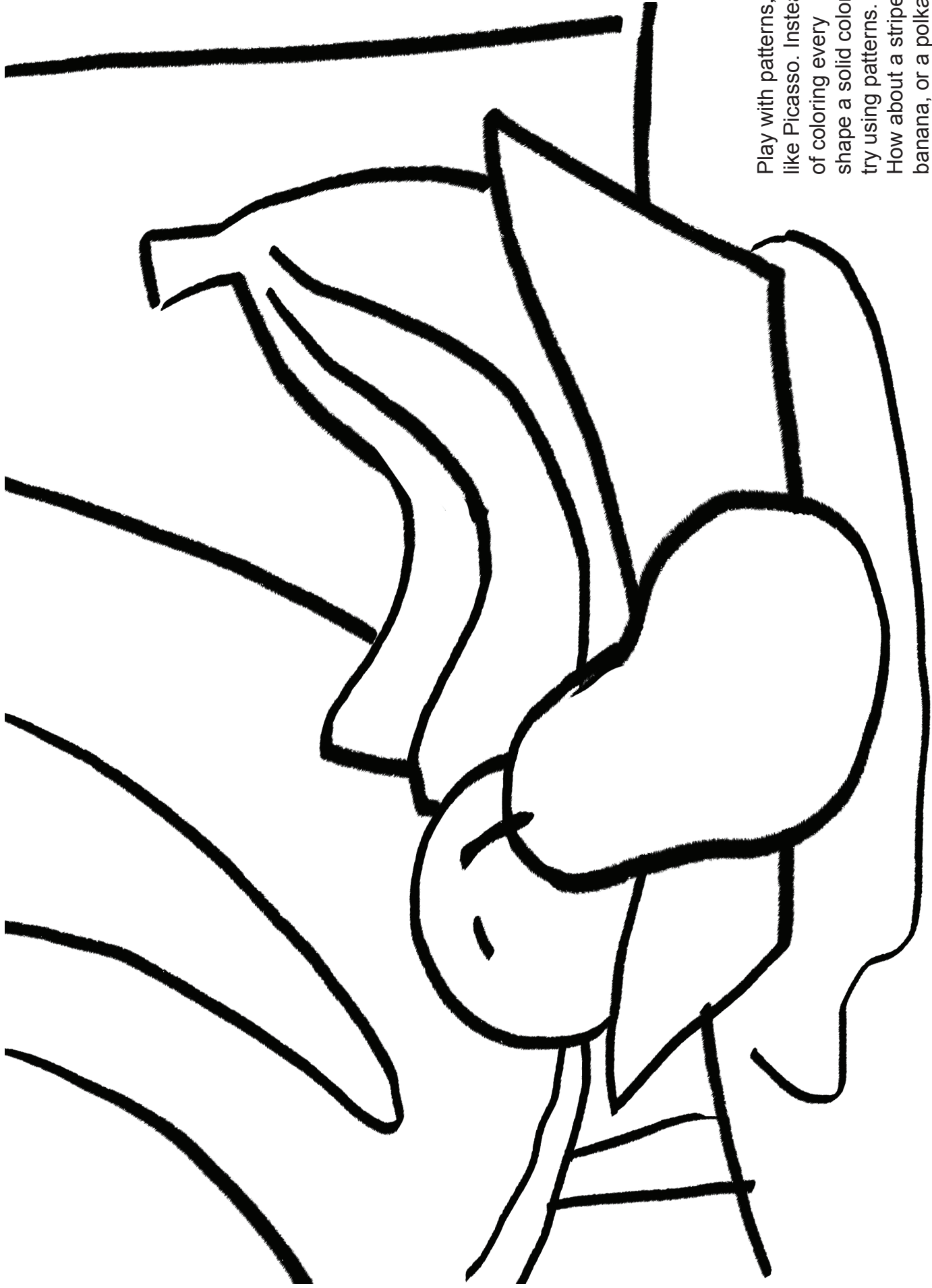
Picasso Paper Doll
