XIDS 2002 – Science and the Art of Water. The goal for this course is to create a learning environment that uses science, specifically biology, and even more specifically water as the catalyst for creative discovery in conjunction with the arts. Through active learning, students will be exposed to basic scientific principles that will be reinterpreted in their own voice using artistic processes to visually show what they have learned. In this course, we start with research as a way to create a dialogue, teach process as a way for students to interpret what they have learned, which will lead to personal inquiry, artistic practice and environmental stewardship.

ART 4985 – Special Topics, 3D Technology. Emphasis on this course is on acquiring technical skills and learning the safe and appropriate use of tools and materials in the fabrication of sculptural objects. This course addresses the impact of material and technique upon form and content with the use of mass, space and volume. Assignments are given to assist students in the development of conceptual ideas, aesthetic quality, and craftsmanship. In this course, you will be introduced to various digital processes to aid in the creation of three-dimensional artwork. You will be utilizing 3D scanning and printing, CNC router, and CNC plasma technologies to aid in your artistic process.
