

Park Place Out West is a 112-page monograph with 64 black and white photographs, an introductory essay, and an afterword. This book represents a significant portion of my work in the national parks, monuments, and wilderness areas of the American West between 1992 and 2019. I am fortunate to be working with renowned book publisher, George F. Thompson, and designer David Skolkin. The publication date is February 2023.

Thanks to a grant from Furthermore (a program of the J.M. Kaplan Fund), support from the Center for Study of Place, and private donations, I have reached 40% of the fundraising goal of \$35,000. I am self-funding the remainder of the project and looking for additional support. Donations of any amount are greatly appreciated.


