

Concept

The blue oak, an enduring symbol of strength and endurance, has long thrived in the Napa Valley, witnessing generations of growth and transformation. Design Elements

The artwork's central focus is an awe-inspiring representation of the blue oak's expansive crown, formed from powder-coated aluminum panels and mirroring the tree's intricate branching patterns and unique foliage. The metalwork's layering and openings will play with light and shadow, inviting viewers to discover new facets of the installation throughout the day.

Mounted within the artwork, discreet LEDs will elegantly illuminate the blue oak during the evening hours. The gentle glow from the back lighting LEDs will create a striking contrast between the luminous tree and the surrounding darkness.

Message

"Roots of Resilience" seeks to convey a profound message to the middle school's community and visitors alike. It emphasizes the importance of embracing challenges, growing together as a united community, and nurturing an unyielding spirit. 
Conclusion



Location Map






Site Plan Art work location

Materials

- i-graffiti coating
- 3" reveal from finished surface
- matched to the powder coat finish
- varm white and dimmable



or general dirt.

- Remove dust with a wet sponge rather than risk micro scratching the surface by dry dusting.
- Most marks or surface contaminants can be removed by the use of a warm water and mild detergent.
- Wash and remove deposits from the powder coating surface using a soft bristle brush or similar.
- Always rinse afterwards with fresh water so that the contact time of the cleaning solution is kept to a minimum.

Maintenance

It is recommended that the powder coated surface should be regularly cleaned to remove airborne deposits such as salt, atmospheric pollution
