

**Leslie Wagner** graduated from Parsons School of Design in New York City, and studied at Parsons in Paris. After graduation, her creative process was informed by a near death experience at the age of twenty while traveling in Egypt; she then developed a practice of Zen meditation, reflected in several group shows addressing the subject. She has been shown at various untraditional non-profit gallery spaces like Village Zendo in New York and San Francisco Zen Center in California. She has also supported non-profit organizations such as the Blue Ocean Institute by exhibiting at Solomon Projects in Atlanta, Georgia. Her work and has been seen in solo exhibitions including the Hans Weiss Newspace Gallery in Manchester, CT. Her research has led her to travel to many sacred spaces throughout the world, culminating in a residency at Great Vow Zen Monastery in Oregon. She is the recipient of two Hemera Fellowship Tending Spaces for Artists awards (2017 and 2018), a fellowship to the Vermont Studio Center, and was awarded a scholarship to an artist residency in the Azores, Portugal. She was born, lives, and works in New York City.
