HARDWARE STORE

Awl (or a \*Whitney Punch)  
Aluminum Pop Rivets 1/8" Dia x 1/8" Grip Range  
Steel Washers 1/8" 3mm  
Pop Rivet Gun  
Light Weight Hammer (24 oz. Ball Peen is what I use)  
Utility Cutters  
Tin Snips /Aviation Shears  
Pocket Knife or Box Cutter  
Needle Nose Pliers

CRAFT STORE

Hole Puncher 1/8<sup>th</sup> Size  
Eyelets 3/16s"  
Eyelet Setter  
22 Gauge Wire Lengths  
Steel Bench Block  
Fine Line Sharpie

Sharp Scissors OR Bonsai Shears (available at StoneLantern.com)  
Empty Cereal Box or Other Light Weight Cardboard  
Barrel Snap Swivel Size 12 or 14 (Local Sporting Goods )  
Aluminum Cans (They are everywhere! People throw them away!)  
Cookie tin lid  
Rubbing Alcohol- (for removing Sharpie ink or for cuts)  
Paper Towels  
Bandages (just in case)  
Piece of wood (Scrap plywood 3"x 3" or whatever)  
Work Gloves  
Tetanus Shot

\*Only get one of these if you're going to be making a lot of birds or doing other tin work. They are \$40 at Grizzly.com
