BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Jennifer Bishop is a figurative painter in the Washington, DC, area who works primarily in oils and mixed media. She was born and raised in Dallas, Texas and began painting at age 14 under the guidance of Marilu Flores Gruben. She earned a B.F.A. in Painting from Cornell University, where she studied with Victor Kord. Her work has been exhibited at the Fraser Gallery, McLean Project for the Arts, and the Dennis and Philip Ratner Museum. She was one of 54 artists selected to represent Washington, DC in the *Art in Hand* deck of playing cards designed by local artists and available in the Phillips Collection and Smithsonian American Art Museum shops. Her art is in private and corporate collections, including GE Healthcare and the Arthritis Foundation. She is a resident artist at Artists & Makers Studios in Rockville, MD.
