



Nina Bellucci is a mixed-media and installation artist who draws inspiration from nature and explores the practice of mindfulness as a means for slowing down in art and in life. Her recent “banner paintings”, intended to be viewed in-the-round, pay homage to awe-inspiring moments in nature, and underscore the importance of taking time to notice the world around.

Born and raised in sunny Florida, Bellucci received her BFA from the University of South Florida (2006) and an MFA from Boston University (2009). She has won numerous awards including a Massachusetts Cultural Council Artist Grant in Painting (2018) and a Joan Mitchell Fellowship nomination (2022). She has exhibited nationally for many years, including most recently at Gallery263, Cambridge, MA; Warnes Contemporary, NYC; and Tender Art Space, Concord, MA. Her work is represented by Uprise Art, NYC. Bellucci maintains a studio in Waltham, MA and lives in Newton, MA with her family.
