# ART RESUME OF MATTHEW BENSON-PARRY / DRAEGATH 2025

Matt Benson Parry / Draegath, is a visual artist whose practice of 25 years spans the intricate worlds of figurative and abstract expressionism, and the innovative use of natural materials, informed by ancient and contemporary practice. Benson Parry's work is deeply rooted in the exploration of identity, transformation, and the interplay between the tangible and the ethereal.

Benson Parry delves into whimsical explorations of the Australian landscape, as well as darker, more introspective narratives, creating evocative pieces that challenge conventional artistic boundaries. Along with his use of encaustic wax techniques, Benson Parry has mastered the harvesting and preparation of balga resin, a localised and culturally significant material derived from the Australian grass tree (*Xanthorrhoea preissii*), which he incorporates into his mixed media works. This unique approach, shared by only a handful of artists such as Christopher Pease and Sharyn Egan, reflects Benson Parry's commitment to sustainability, cultural reverence, and the fusion of traditional materials with contemporary art practices. Through his layered, textural paintings, Benson Parry invites viewers to engage with the profound connections between land, memory, and creativity, offering a transformative experience that celebrates the beauty of the unconventional and the power of artistic innovation.

Benson Parry is based in Fremantle, Australia. He has been involved in a number of solo and group shows in Australia, Canada, US, Portugal & UK. Benson Parry was previously represented by Rolf Contemporary Art Gallery in LA and Broderick Art Consultancy in Perth. In 2014 he was the recipient of an International Scholarship to attend 8th Symposium of Encaustic Art in Provincetown, Massachusetts, USA. In 2006, he was the recipient of the Robert Tindale Scholarship for Fine Arts while at the University of Western Australia. Outside of his own practice, Benson Parry conducts classes for adults and children in painting, drawing and encaustic wax techniques. He works as a teacher at Byford Secondary College.
