Angela finds inspiration in the scenery of her daily life. Her work is full of color, thick brushstrokes and lively expression. She paints travelled landscapes, favorite local spots, especially Edmonton's grand river valley, experienced streetscapes, expressive floral pieces, soulful musical instruments with figures, and other figurative works. Angela is a mother of two, a teacher and a painter in both acrylic and oil forms.

Some of the critiques about Angela's art and artist process has been described by her art professors as 'prolific' (Harold Pearse), 'the meat and potatoes of painting' (Allan Ball), and 'displays an internal connection between her and the masters of the past' (Tessa Nunn).

The artist now describes her own work as an impression and expression of her environment,. Most recently she has said 'All of my pieces have colour and texture. It is in your face and 'rough around the edges' meant to make you pause and feel it.'
