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About

My artwork reflects how I experience life, drawing inspiration from nature and my responses to personal, social, and environmental events. I see nature as a unified whole, emerging from interconnected elements in constant transformation and grow. This vision takes form in many of my works through non-representational, three-dimensional paper montages within translucent layers, where unfixed elements create open-ended compositions that echo nature's unpredictability.

In photography, I often explore its selective portrayal of reality, shaped by decisions about what to reveal and what to omit. This outlook informs my unconventional approach to the medium, encouraging alternative ways of seeing.

Central to my work is an exploration of the fluidity of beliefs, memories, time, movement, and perception, with light at its core. Its shifting nature captures the impossibility of fixity, mirroring the essence of the living. Harmonies and tensions unfold through the interplay of colors, patterns, spaces, and forms, inviting viewers into a continuous visual and conceptual engagement.
