

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
## **Images of Student Work**




## Drawing 1: Texture (2021)

PART A: 6 spaces (3 x 3-inch boxes) drawn in a grid format with a different texture placed in each box. Each texture develops a different mark making system.

PART B: Enlarge a textural object (cacti, gourd, shell, leaf etc.) until it is beyond a namable object. 18" x 24"






2D Design: Unity and Variety (2023)
