[Burgess Shale](#) The Burgess Shale located 2300 metres above sea level in the Canadian Rockies at Yoho National Park in British Columbia are fossils of the earliest mobile creatures that evolved in what would have been a Cambrian sea. My 'new hybrids' sprung from my exploration of fossils in that they are reminders of past creatures that had evolved long before and made me wonder what may evolve in the future in a world of diminished species.
