

BIOGRAPHY

Isadora (Stowe) Jackson is a multimedia artist whose work investigates how psychological, emotional, and ecological landscapes shape our sense of place. Rooted in the U.S.–Mexico borderlands where she grew up, her practice translates geography, memory, and identity into layered visual languages using symbols, maps, and architectural forms to explore how real and imagined boundaries inform belonging.

Jackson holds a BFA in Painting with a double major in Cultural Anthropology and a minor in Native American Studies, and an MFA in Painting and Drawing from New Mexico State University. This interdisciplinary foundation continues to guide a practice where personal narrative meets cultural research.

She is an Associate Professor of Art in El Paso, Texas, teaching painting, drawing, and professional practices with an emphasis on creative sustainability and community engagement. Jackson's work has been widely exhibited, collected nationally and in Mexico, and is represented in multiple permanent public collections. Her awards include recognition from the New Mexico Committee of the National Museum of Women in the Arts, as well as the Minnie Stevens Piper Professor nomination and an Outstanding Faculty Achievement Award.

Her practice has been featured in magazines, newspapers, podcasts, and radio, and in books such as *The Motherhood of Art* and *Painting Our World*. She also actively supports artists through service on local and national committees, including the College Art Association Professional Practices Committee and the board of the Texas Association of Schools of Art. She is a founding member of *Borderlines*, an initiative fostering exhibitions, residencies, and exchanges for emerging artists across New Mexico, Texas, and New York.

Working across painting, installation, projection, and light-based media, Jackson creates conversations that connect disciplines, cultures, and environments, illuminating the complex relationships between people and the places they inhabit.
