

Conny Hatch (b. Salem, MA 1952) is a minimalist assemblage artist working primarily with wood and metal found objects. Local history finds its way into Hatch's work as she re-purposes the cast off elements of someone else's life into raw materials for her sculptures. The discarded materials themselves are the main source of the artist's inspiration. Hatch integrates each group of objects into a new whole that changes our perception.

Hatch has taught sculptural workshops at the Truro Center for the Arts at Castle Hill, Truro, MA as well as the Provincetown Art Association and Museum, Provincetown, MA. She is a recipient of the prestigious Pollack-Krasner Foundation Grant (2007). Her work has been included in numerous exhibitions and is in collections throughout the U.S. and Europe.
