Architectural Art

Architecture has been the inspiration for my art for over thirty years. An early career as an interior designer instilled in me a fascination with the design of floor plans and elevation drawings. I manipulate my digital photos of architecture in Photoshop, frequently eliminating objects or distorting the context of the original image. Piecing portions of different architectural elements that are unrelated to each other, I construct new, intriguing, familiar, yet unfamiliar architectural forms in my paintings. My application of oils, mixed with cold wax medium sometimes suggest fresco walls, concrete or steel; linear detail with graphite and pencils provides a visual pathway throughout the painting and may imply elements of an architectural drawing. All works displayed are original on archival Claybord panels.

I welcome the opportunity to do site specific commissions of homes, commercial buildings, or a body of work by an architectural firm or real estate developer.

Exploring the endless possibilities of architectural compositions, without the need to be concerned with the feasibility to actually build these designs, gives me the artistic freedom that architects seldom have. My pieces welcome repeated visual engagement and discovery and may be hung either vertically or horizontally, which allows the viewer multiple perspectives and interpretations of the composition.

Commission Process

I welcome commissions and specialize in three types – standard, site specific and firm specific.

- 1) Standard commissions would be a painting of a specific size, using photos from my existing files. Client may specify colors be included in the palette. The price of these commissions would be the same price as my current prices for the same size.
- 2) Site specific commissions are of a building or residence. I photograph the subject, taking about 150-200 shots...interiors, exteriors, daytime and evening, looking for unique architectural angles and details of the structure. I Photoshop all the photos to be used as collage. These paintings are priced 50% higher than the standard price for paintings of the same size.
- 3) Firm specific commissions are of a body of work by one architect or firm and would include more than one project. I prefer to take the photos, whenever possible, however, sometimes I can include photos from the files of the architect. These paintings are also priced up to 50% higher than the standard price.

A 50% deposit is required to begin the process. This also secures a space in my schedule. I will email conceptual ideas and welcome feedback from the client. I can also send progress emails showing the work in various stages. Before final detail is done, the client is consulted again.

Final payment is due prior to shipping the painting.
