

COVID-19 Safety guidelines.

Shop safety guidelines

1. Everyone should wash their hands first thing after entering the shop (and every time you re-enter after running an errand)
2. Maintain a social distance of 3ft with each other, and avoid all physical contacts.
3. Do not share any food or drinks.
4. The shop must be cleaned and carefully sanitized. Use sanitized wipes several times a day on: Door knobs, toilets, and faucets handles.
5. To avoid crowding the shop, we will space out appointments by 30 min minimum, and 1h whenever possible. Moving appointments will be necessary.
6. Signs will be displayed throughout the shop to help people understand our policies. We will contact people through emails and social media to keep them informed.
7. Shop managers have authority over those Health guidelines. They should not hesitate to kindly remind artists and clients to follow them whenever necessary.

Client safety guidelines

1. If a client has any symptoms; or has been exposed to sick people, or has travelled to sensitive areas in the past 2 weeks (China, Iran, Italia, Korea), or other containment zones, they must reschedule their appointment.
2. Clients should come alone; no friends, no exceptions.
3. Clients should wash their hands first things when getting in the shop.
4. Clients should be kindly explained that we use social distancing. They should stay 3ft away from other people unless they are getting tattooed.
5. Clients should wash their hands before leaving the shop.

Artists safety guidelines

1. Tattoo stations, tattoo beds, and arm rest must be carefully sanitized before and after each tattoo.
2. Please greet your clients without any physical contacts.
3. Maintain a social distance of 3ft with your clients, unless you are ready to start the tattoo process (stencil placement, etc)
4. Before you start the tattoo process, wash your hands, then put on a mask, and keep it throughout the tattoo process.
5. Wear gloves as soon as you start touching clients, even for stencils and other usually safe acts.
6. When you are entirely done with the tattoo including aftercare, remove your mask, and go wash your hands.
