Michele Foyer is an artist who lives and works in San Francisco. She holds an MFA from the San Francisco Art Institute and a BA from UC Berkeley (*cum laude* + department honors). She is the 2019 inaugural artist for IMPLY Art Program curated by Anne Albagli. She has mounted a solo show at MAX Occupancy and exhibited at Axis Gallery, Aggregate Space Orium III, SOMArts, Southern Exposure, Start Up Art Fair, Gallery Route One, Studio 110 Projects, Luggage Store, LIMN, Diego Rivera Gallery, Swell Gallery, and Sanchez Art Center in the Bay Area.
