Fine Art Coordinator - Mendocino Art Center - Mendocino, California September 2016 to October 2017

Responsible for scheduling courses taught by a range of diverse international fine artists. Artists would submit proposals to teach a course ranging from drawing, painting and printmaking techniques. As coordinator I was also responsible for reviewing proposals, scheduling classes and studio maintenance.

Business owner - Tugboat Paper & Press - San Francisco, California August 2005 to December 2006

Conceived and initiated the first completely sustainable letterpress and handmade paper shop in the U.S.

Using only recycled and organically grown fibers I created customized handmade paper and letterpress printings using soy-based inks. By creating wedding invitations, business cards, stationery and more I offered a completely sustainable product for the eco-friendly consumer.

Papermaker - Taos Paperworks - Taos, New Mexico September 1998 to August 1999

Assisted in the production of all handmade paper designs both stock and custom orders. Worked directly with local artisans and their individual creations in handmade paper. Maintained and operated all studio equipment.

Letterpress Printer/Offset lithography finisher - SOHO Service - N.Y.C., New York August 1993 to August 1995

Responsible for pre-press and letterpress printing on handmade and machine made papers. Fine art editions, wedding invitations, menus, birth announcements and business cards were created. Worked on pre-press and finishing (cutting, binding and folding machines) for all offset lithography jobs.

I performed numerous necessities for the mill such as: the preparation of fibers, drying and curating paper. Worked on the production of sheets, envelopes, etc. Assisted in the fabrication of papers for artists such as Sol Lewitt and John Cage.

Completed a week-long residency assisting artists with developmentally disabilities create silkscreen prints of their work as posters and T-shirts.

The Fort Bragg mural competition is an annual event designed to connect businesses with professional mural artists from California, Oregon and Washington. I implemented this project by working with city officials and the event will held annually beginning in 2017.

Noyo Printworks - Fort Bragg 2014

I created and initiated a community based printmaking studio in Fort Bragg, Ca. I worked with city council members to design a space offering classes and studio time in letterpress, etching and relief.

Potrero Hill Neighborhood House - San Francisco, California November 2003 to July 2008

Worked as an instructor at a recreational day program for adults who are developmentally disabled. I planned and implemented projects and activities on a daily basis offering opportunities for creative expression, recreation and living skills. Individuals with varying degrees of autism, Down syndrome, mental and physical disabilities engaged in recreational and therapeutic activities including art, cooking, communication and physical needs.

Potrero Hill Neighborhood House - San Francisco, California January 2004 to March 2006

Worked as an after school art instructor for 'at-risk' youth, ages six to eleven and fourteen to seventeen. The children explored their artistic abilities in a variety of ways such as printmaking, paper-making, painting, drawing and sculpture. I proposed and curated a large exhibition of the children's work (as well as my own) at SOMArts Cultural Center in San Francisco titled "My Life in the Sunshine".

Marshall Elementary School - San Francisco, California March 2002

Taught a volunteer arts and crafts workshop open to Mission area elementary schools. I worked with low-income area youth creating art from found objects.

Millicent Rogers Museum - Taos, New Mexico November 1998

Assisted children age five to twelve in a workshop designed to celebrate Native American and Spanish culture, creating culturally relative art.

Studio Technical Abilities

Printmaking: Intaglio, Lithography, Silkscreen, Relief, Letterpress, Paper-making, Bookbinding, pre-press film processing and photographic transfer methods. Photographic printmaking techniques including photo-lithography, photo-silkscreen, photo-intaglio, photopolymer letterpress and solarplate etching.

Digital Media: Adobe Creative Suite, Digital Photography, Archival printing methods-Inkjet vs Laser, large format ink-jet printer systems, Final Cut Pro, Microsoft Office, Digital video, Lighting, Image projection and installation.
