Kate Budd was born in Nairobi, Kenya in 1969. She received a BA (Hons) degree from Gray's School of Art in Aberdeen, Scotland (1990) and an MFA in Sculpture from Southern Illinois University at Carbondale (1995).

Kate Budd has received four Individual Excellence Awards from the Ohio Arts Council and her work has been exhibited in numerous group exhibits, including *State of the Art 2020* at Crystal Bridges Museum of American Art, Bentonville, Arkansas. Solo exhibits include *tableau* at William Busta Gallery in Cleveland, Ohio; *Kate Budd*, Gallery at Vaudeville, Fredericksburg, Texas; *Kate Budd: On Site Ohio* at the Akron Art Museum and *Talisman* at Kenyon College, Ohio. Her work has been reviewed in *Art in America*, *New Art Examiner* and *Sculpture* magazines and is in the collections of Wright State University, Dayton, Ohio and the Progressive Collection, Cleveland, Ohio.

Kate is a Professor of Art at the Myers School of Art where she has taught 3-D Design and Sculpture since 1998.
