ARTIST BIO:

Jimmy McBride (b. 1979) is a Brooklyn, New York based artist combining a deep appreciation of art and art history with manipulated source material found on the internet to examine how masculinity is constructed and presented in our modern time. By viewing Instagram gym influencer videos through the lens of Andy Warhol's "Screen Tests" and Reddit user's dick pics in the context of a Yasumasa Morimura "Self Portrait" (via a Henry Moore sculpture), he uses humor to draw attention to the peculiarity of the masculine facade.
