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ARTIST'S STATEMENT

The imagery in my work is a version of the constant swirl I have in my mind as I go about the daily tasks of my life. The interplay of abstract imagery with more concrete representations of my environment, my home, the land and waterways are interesting to me as an artist here in Central Oregon.

BIOGRAPHY

Andrew Walter Loomis was born and raised in Yakima, Washington where he developed an interest in drawing at an early age. His artistic career started while he was in high school, painting commissioned watercolors and participating in juried art competitions. His formal studies were continued at Washington State University. there he earned a Bachelor of Arts in English and a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Painting and Print Making. It was during his college studies that his present styles and appreciation of the unique characteristics of the Pacific Northwest began to emerge.

After completing college, Andrew worked as a Patina Craftsman in the fine art foundries in the Portland, Troutdale, Boring and Sandy, Oregon, where he worked with local artists and craftspersons. At the same time, he exhibited his paintings and prints across the western United States.

His style incorporates both realism and abstraction as well as the use of rich colors and bold lines. Andrew's acrylics, watercolors, linoleum prints and mixed media assemblages explore our relationship to our environment by intertwining cultural images and designs with representational portrayals of the plants and landscapes of the great Northwest. Andrew's work has been exhibited in Washington, Oregon, Idaho, Montana and Georgia and purchased by collectors throughout the United States. He presently lives and works in Sisters, Oregon with wife Sandy.
