ART RELATED EMPLOYMENT

2005-2016 - Art Strand Gallery, Provincetown, MA - one of seven owners of a Provincetown art gallery where we showed our work as well as curated shows of invited artists from the United States and abroad. I helped operate the gallery and I had a show of my work each summer for twelve years.

2000-2011 - Fine Arts Work Center, Provincetown, MA - Visual Arts

Coordinator - coordinated and ran the seven month Visual Arts Residency Program for the ten emerging Visual Arts Fellows in residence at FAWC from September to May of each year. The ten emerging artists are selected from a pool of international applicants by a jury of well respected artists. They receive a stipend, a studio, living quarters, and uninterrupted time to work on their art. My duties included bringing in visiting artists for artist talks and critiques, scheduling shows in the Hudson D. Walker Gallery to include the individual shows for each of the Visual Arts Fellows, coordinating any shows or activities for the Visual Arts Fellows outside of FAWC, organizing the jury and jury process.

1998-1999 - Artist In Residence, Provincetown, MA - worked as Artist in

Residence in the Provincetown Schools on various visual projects that reached beyond the normal school arts curriculum. **1995-2000 - Arts In Education, Utica, NY** - Teaching Artist for the Arts In Education program in the Central New York area. Worked with students in grades K-12 on projects in the genres of visual art, writing, dance, and music to prepare and broaden their knowledge as viewers for exhibitions and performances by major international artists, musicians, dance troupes and writers.

1988-1989 - Artist in Residence, Rome, NY - worked as Artist in Residence for the Rome Art and Community Center on visual projects for children and adults living in the vicinity of Rome, NY.
