I am an artist drawn to and by the spiritual and emotive power of the natural world. I have a constant desire within me to synthesize powerful moments that I experience outdoors and communicate them with the world. The mood and mystery we experience out in nature is such an overwhelming comfort to me that I can't help but be deeply inspired by it.

Artist Bio

Devin Michael Roberts (b. 1984) is an American contemporary realist artist combining aspects of minimalist and tonalist philosophies with classical, impressionist and modernist techniques. Born in the foot hills of the Cascade Mountains and raised up and down the west coast as a child. Nature has always

played an important role in Devin's life and as a result of that intimate connection he has put his primary focus on painting the landscape. Mr. Roberts finds that the landscape affords endless opportunities to focus on representing living emotion through paint. "The moods and feelings that Mother Nature can evoke are infinite" His days and nights are spent either in the field studying directly from nature or in the comfort of the studio painting well thought out emotive pieces.

Influenced by a wide array of artists from the illustrator N.C. Wyeth to the tonalist George Inness and from the Russian Impressionist Isaac Levitan to the modern abstract artist Gerhard Richter.

Mr. Roberts has a technical process that is ever evolving. He currently puts a focus on beginning his paintings from life, either from a study done on location or from life in the studio. He takes these studies and uses them as the reference for his studio paintings. The studio paintings often are pieces which combine multiple references including video, photography and plein air studies. Roberts takes all these various references and combines different elements together when composing a larger studio scene. The goal of these studio pieces is to build an emotional experience within the viewer and not to represent a physical location.

" I try to get people out of the frame of mind where they need to know something features a certain geographic location in order for them to be interested in purchasing or collecting it.. I'm much more interested in creating a piece that provides the viewer with a sense of mystery and emotion, to the point where they just have to own it. Whether the mountain is in the Rockies or the Cascades, or whether the ocean scene is on the east coast or west coast, in my opinion it's irrelevant. The question we viewers should be asking ourselves is how does it make me feel? If it makes you feel like a memory of being on the ocean on the west coast as a child, telling you it features the east coast might subdue that initial reaction."

Over the last couple years Devin Michael Roberts' career has begun to expand rather quickly. Going from a largely regional artist to gathering national press and gallery representation as well as beginning to collect national awards and invites to some of the more prestigious landscape painting events around the country.
