Classes include 'Drawn to Print', 'Contemporary Textile Print Production: Art & Design' and 'Advanced Print for Fabric and Alternative Materials.' Undergraduate and graduate students from many disciplines and levels of experience build a mastery of screen printing on fabric. Print techniques, dyeing, and heat transfer methods are instructed as well as digital and analog modes for image making. Critical thinking, research and professional practice are themes that also tie into each class. In some cases, market research, commercial printing and site-specific project proposals are also explored.
