

Centennial Exchange

A year before I was scheduled to retire from the University of Miami, I came up with this idea for a print exchange of students and colleagues who have been involved with the UM printmaking area during my time. Since it was the University's Centennial year, that seemed like the most appropriate name for the portfolio. I am grateful for some financial support for this project from the Department of Art & Art History and the Miami Dade Individual Artist grant program so the participants did not have to contribute any funds other than their own materials and getting their prints to Miami.

The group in this portfolio includes former BFA and MFA students (some with more than one degree from UM) and two outstanding full-time colleagues who have been central to the success of the printmaking area: Jonathan Beaumont Thomas (currently the Head of Printmaking at Maryland Institute College of Art) and Lani Shapton, our current Senior Lecturer, who has been with the University for 15 years. The artists in this portfolio have been in an impressive number of solo and group exhibitions, along with earning numerous residencies and grants and placing their works in great collections. What's important is that they are all actively pursuing their art careers; which says a lot about the quality of students who have come through UM's programs. They represent all the others who have graduated from the University's programs and found success in different visual art fields.


Some of them continue to work for the University of Miami. Kyle Trowbridge is a Senior Lecturer of Painting and UM's Undergraduate Director. Daniele Gabriel has taught 2D Design, Drawing and Intro to Electronic Media for us as well as other classes at MDC Kendall. Jeannette Stargala has taught Drawing, 2D and 3D Design, and interdisciplinary classes in the DaVinci program, as well as book arts classes at the New World School of the Arts. Barbara Scheer has taught full time and part time for us in Graphic Design, Printmaking and 2D Design and remotely at New Mexico Highlands University.

Others continue to work in South Florida. Victoria Rose Martin has taught in multiple studio disciplines and is department chair at Palm Beach State College. Jennifer Basile and Claudia Scalise are both Full Professors at different campuses of Miami Dade College. Abraham Camayd teaches at South Miami Middle School Magnet Center for the Arts. Charlisa Montrope teaches at Somserset Academy Charter High full time and MDC Kendall part time. Brian Reedy teaches in the Miami Dade Public School system and Rachel Alderton Rippes runs the art program at Schott Communities and also adjuncts part time at different area programs. Tom Virgin had a full career with Miami Dade Public Schools, and then formed Extra Virgin Press with the help of Knight Foundation funds. Kathleen Hudspeth is an artist, educator and arts writer who used her Knight Foundation grant to become a co-founder of Turn Based Press; she most recently taught at the New World School of the Arts and is currently a full-time artist.

Some of them have moved on to find success elsewhere. John McCaffrey teaches interactive design and animation at Hennepin Technical College in Minnesota. Nicole Hand is a full Professor at Murray State University in Kentucky. Scott Smith is an Associate Professor at Alabama A & M University in Hunstville. Eddy A. Lopez is an Associate Professor at Bucknell University in Lewisburg, Pennsylvania. Beatriz Rodriguez is an Assistant Professor at Wayne State University in Nebraska. Christine Di Staola teaches part time and maintains her studio in Gulfport, Florida. Thomas J. Engleman teaches at Maryland Institute in Baltimore. Kari Fernandez has her studio in Asheville, North Carolina where she also teaches part time. Randi Matushevitz is a full-time artist in Los Angeles, working in painting, installation video and digital media. Our most recent MFA in printmaking, Catherine Kramer, is in the process of buying a press and setting up her studio in New Orleans.














