A Ritual of Recognition, Initiatory Rites with Kay Turner, Tappeto Volante Gallery, 2024

This dual performance was created for a two-person exhibition, Pale Hekate's Team, June 9th 2024 - July 21st 2024 at Tappeto Volante Gallery with Large scale ceramic sculpures in the round and on the wall by Elizabeth Insogna and paintings and drawings by Jesse Bransford. This exhibition drew from magical vocabulary through abstraction and embodied performance. Insogna's works returns to Hekate, goddess of the ancient world, with symbology related to choice, power and construction of the crossroads. The works and the performance served as a bridge, a metaphor to transform via fire, a wheel of time, and a cave which burrows into the earth multi-directionally. In the dual performance, Kay Turner re-created a site specific work enacted only once before for Mary Beth Edelson. Elizabeth Insogna's large scale ceramic work had a one night transformation for the performance, Intitiatory Rites. Participants were brought in one at a time for the ritual.














The Double Sun Performance with Kay Turner, activating Insogna's sculptures, 2024

Elizabeth Insogna created over a hundred serpents envisioning The Croning as a circle of life, fluidity, the original form of the goddess and a bridge from one point of life to another in a person's journey from a menstruating body to one that has moved through menopause. Conceived by Liz Collins for her site-specific Installation, we worked to create a space of enlivened ritual performance, a ceremony, akin to any other great ceremony that marks time in the social sphere, as a coming of age ceremony or wedding. We performed together in a ritual led by Kay Turner to create this special event.
