| CURRENT Administrative Responsibilities

Responsible for directing and coordinating the activities of the academic departments of the school; for coordinating and communicating an academic vision and long range academic planning together with the Dean and Department Chairs; planning and implementing academic policies, procedures and systems; coordinating with all other departments on faculty and academic issues; and managing faculty personnel procedures, committee assignments and workloads. Is the primary college leader with regard to accreditation and the assessment and evaluation of academic programs.

| CURRENT Essential Functions

- In collaboration with the Dean, provides strategic and long-range direction and vision for all academic programs at the college. Oversees long-term academic initiatives working with the department chairs and program supervisors.
- Supervises the Academic Program Manager, and is responsible for the overall management of the academic affairs office, including all activities and records involving faculty, curriculum, and academic programs. Supervises the maintenance of up-to-date adjunct and core faculty files and vitae.
- Supervises Academic Department Chairs, and AIB's Director of Academic Computing; coordinates activities and programs both internally and with other departments throughout the University. Represents Department Chairs, and makes recommendations regarding academic programs to the Dean, Provost, and other University administrators. Informs Department Chairs (and faculty) of all planning schedules and deadlines, particularly in regards to budget and course planning.
- Oversees the development and implementation of academic polices, procedures and systems that ensure adherence to standards and maintain academic quality of all programs. Directs the review of academic policies, as needed.
- Oversees instructional budgets, and has budgetary signoff for multiple school budgets.
- Directs the assessment, evaluation and program review process of the school's programs; maintains academic records as appropriate; and supervises administrative documentation and compliance with accreditation standards and state regulations. Directs accreditation reviews, in consultation with the Dean.
- In consultation with the Dean and Department Chairs appoints faculty to all school-based committees, and charges committees with tasks as needed, as well as faculty appointments to University-wide committees. Coordinates communication between committees and between faculty and committees, and provides administrative assistance to faculty (for school and committee business) through the academic affairs office.
- Serves as ex-officio member of the curriculum committee and, approves all curricular programs and changes passed by the curriculum committee. Supervises the

implementation of curricular programs and changes, and maintenance of academic program records.

- Responsible for informing students of academic actions (such as placement of students on warning, probation, or dismissal; or on dean's list) and managing the appeals process, together with the school's Academic Policies committee.
- Has a primary leadership role in researching, assessing, and implementing outside partnerships, exchange and articulation agreements, and national and international programs.
- Collaborates with faculty and administrators throughout the University on a variety of projects and initiatives, and represents the school on various committees and task forces.
- Assists the Dean and provides academic information as necessary. Provides academic research, analysis, and recommendations regarding academic programs. Is a member of the Dean's council and consults on all aspects of the school's programs and plans.
- Teaches courses as assigned.

| Artist Statement

I straddle the worlds of contemporary art practitioners with observational artists interested in figural constructs. My concepts and narratives are integrated and woven with a formal additive/subtractive process layering washes, glazes, marks, and drips that are accumulative and serve as a summation of documented thoughts, impulses and reactions. Balancing representation with abstraction, expressionism and pure mark making, the blend creates a final object with the process integral to the purity of its intent. My energies and oeuvre focus on the depiction of the face, head, bust and body, usually depicted in direct and frontal positions. My work contributes to a dialogue on identity, individuality, masculinity/femininity, gender, beauty, time and aging, relationships, the mundane or ordinary as contrasted with the ideal, and the self in reference to pop culture as I document random people I connect with in life, on the streets and via social media.
