Manage a staff of 7 and a Board of 8 while overseeing communications and design, running a fundraising committee, and fulfilling grant writing needs responsibilities.

Maintain Diversity and Equity goals of the organization by engaging with caucusing through Enrich Chicago, supporting staff through their DEI training, and re-evaluating protocols of the non-profit to work towards being more inclusive.
