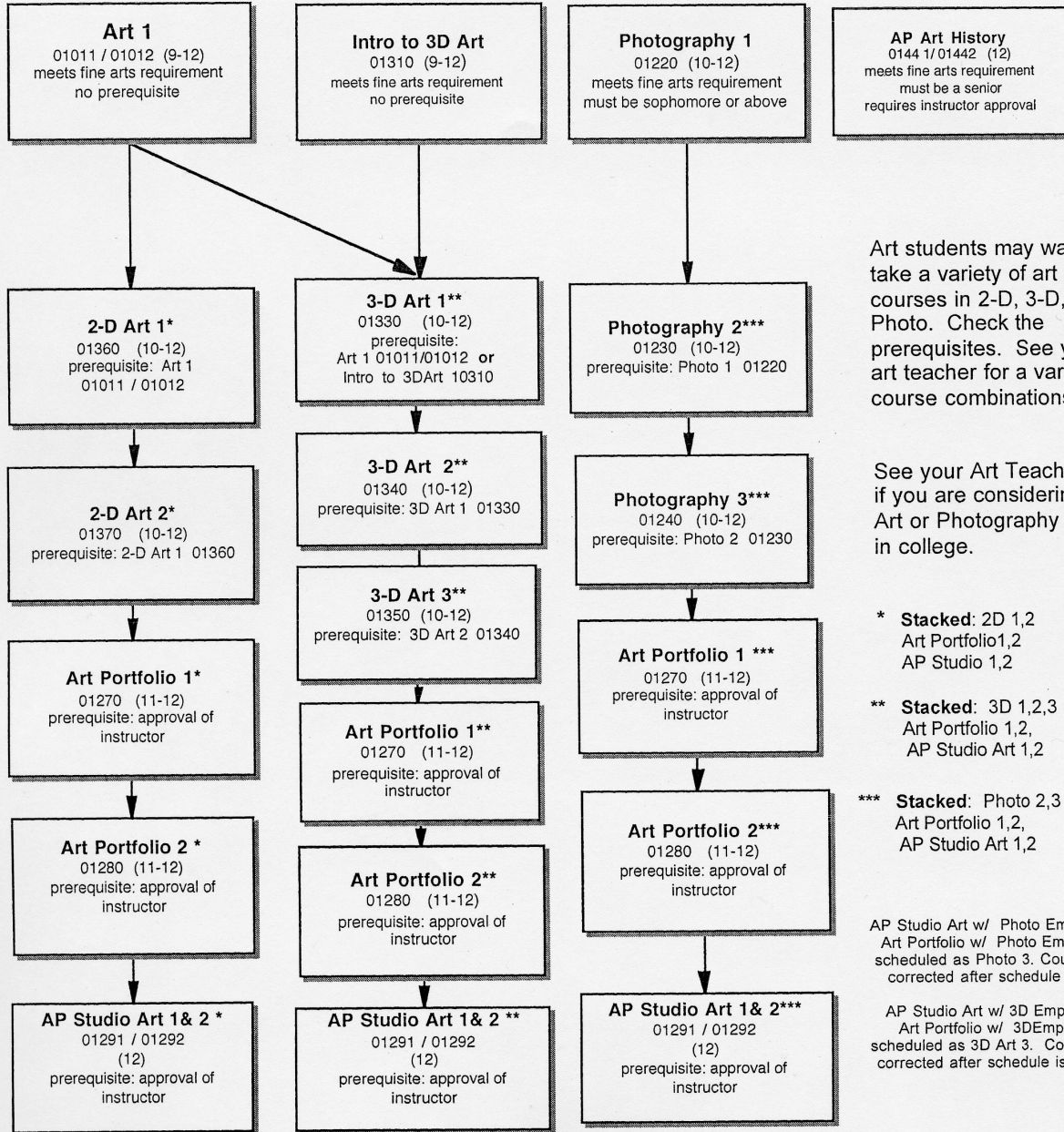


**Prospect High School Art Courses
