## Statement

Sensual and tactile in its use of locally sourced materials such as clay, wood and glass, my work echoes and alchemizes patterns and processes found in the body, the natural world, and in mythology. Forms emerging from my practice are often large and multifaceted, giving the sense that they could be viewed as many things at once: a waterfall, a rock face, a throne, a pelvis, an animal, a dress. Each form is a shapeshifter, often elemental in nature while blending opposing forces of hard/soft, fluid/static, inviting the viewer to connect and imagine.



There is a kind of eros in my work, a sensual longing to fully belong to both the terrain of my own body, but also that of the natural world.

Much of my current creative process engages the prolific study of somatic embodiment practices as a resource for bridging inner and outer connection.
