- 2000 Continues making painterly representational pictures with expanded subject matter: Garden, close up views of Tree Trunks, Still Life, and Figures. Much success with single object compositions: Plates, bowls, vases, tree trunks, which relates to certain past abstract works.
- 2005 Included in a historically important two part exhibition, "Clement Greenberg in Syracuse, Then and Now", May - June at The Company Gallery, Syracuse, NY. Curated by Karen Wilkin. "Now" part of show goes to NYC, September - October of 2006. Documentary Film made to accompany exhibit, called The Mirror Eye, by J.R. Hughto.
- 2006 Focuses on "Tree Portrait" pictures. The format and subject matter is enormously freeing, and seems to enable a melding of abstract and representational aesthetic concerns that have been part of my work for many years.

- 2007 Works on Tree pictures, Landscapes, and a return to making Non-Objective pictures.

- 2008 The discipline of making both abstract and representational pictures enables a cross fertilization that invigorates both bodies of work.

- 2009,10 Begins combining poured paint with thicker palette knife and brush applications. Again, borrowing from methods used in making non-objective works
- 2012,15 New landscape paintings synthesizing and hybridizing influences of early American Modernism with Color Field painting.
- 2015, 23 Continue exploring hill, mountain, sea stack pictures with hybrid variations on these themes and also begins to focus on the Tree Portrait series setting the stage for upcoming exhibitions.
