Please follow the instructions below for delivery dates, formatting, and uploading specifications.

Types of creative work accepted

All forms of visual art, sketches, poetry, spoken word, performances, videos, and other creative projects. Each artist may submit up to 3 pieces in any accepted media.

Submission deadline

Submission period will close **March 18th, 2022**. Submissions will be judged by a selected jury. Artists will be notified if their work is selected by **March 22nd, 2022**

Format for juried submission and gallery exhibition

- Please photograph artwork (drawings, paintings, sculpture, ceramics, etc...) and upload a .jpeg at a resolution of 2000 pixels on the long side. Using your phone to photograph work is fine. (Work may be subject to cropping)
- For all photography or graphic design, please upload a digital copy of the work in .jpeg format at a resolution of 2000 pixels on the long side at 150 ppi.
- For video work please provide a video file or YouTube link to your video. Please make sure that your video is sized at 1920 x 1080 and has 1 second of black at the beginning and end of the video.
- Please contact for submissions files larger than 1 GB
