With approximately six exhibitions per year, Olly Olly provides the local community with access to exceptional, avant garde art, as well as with additional programming such as arts education, interdisciplinary workshops, open studios, and immersive, performative events and poetry readings. Olly Olly works to build a relationship with GMU students, faculty, and staff by providing students and alumni with affordable studio space, proactively seeking out students to participate in exhibitions, and providing incubator space that enables emerging artists and curators to explore and experiment.
