Betty Winkler is an artist, poet, teacher and a Licensed Creative Art Therapist (LCAT). She recently retired from a f/t position at a NYC mental health hospital-based outpatient clinic, where she worked primarily with traumatized adults. With the intensity of this later career, exhibitions were forsaken, although art production continued. Her visual art includes collages, drawings, etchings, paintings and artists' books. Betty has had group and solo exhibitions in numerous places, including New York, Lima, Rome. She has taught at numerous schools and workshops along the eastern seaboard as well as at Kala Institute in Berkeley, CA. For 25 years she was owner and master printer of Yama Prints, www.yamaprints.net, printing limited editions with a diversity of professional artists. She is the author of *Carborundum Collagraph Printmaking* and *The Wednesday Poems*, both available at lulu.com. She graduated from Carnegie-Mellon University (BFA '76) and New York University (MA '08).
