Kathleen Loe is a multi-media artist and independent writer, living in Hudson, NY. She has been a visiting critic at Brown University, Rhode Island School of Design, Louisiana State University and the Pont Aven School of Contemporary Art in France. Loe has taught both studio and art history on the faculties of the School of the Art Institute of Chicago, Illinois Wesleyan University and Bloomfield College. She writes critical essays for artist exhibitions and served as editor and contributing author for the monograph *Alchemy of Light, Mary Conover* published by Whale and Star Press in 2010.
