

BIOGRAPHY

Rachel Goodison is an artist living and working in London. She works across different media, including painting, printing and sculpture. Her work explores various themes including the importance of play in pursuing creativity; and the vulnerability of the human body and mind. She changed career to become an artist in 2015, having trained as a barrister, and worked for a campaign group called London First, an organisation that sought to tackle some of the Capital's issues such as the environment and skills shortage.

She completed her Diploma in Portraiture at the Heatherley School of Fine Art in 2017, and was awarded her Masters in Fine Art at the City & Guilds of London Art School in 2019 with Distinction. She has been made Print Fellow at the City & Guilds, a post which will last two years, and is currently undertaking a 6-month artist's residency at Re:Centre in West London. Her work has appeared in various group exhibitions, and she will be part of group shows, both at Thames-Side Studios Gallery and Re:Centre, in March 2020.
