

Bryan Schnelle (b. 1980 Long Beach, CA) is an American artist working primarily in collage, but occasionally in drawing, painting, sculpture and installation as well. His highly detailed and labor-intensive work examines the blind faith with which we are clinging to late-stage capitalism, and the space where religion and consumerism intersect. Much of his work uses common advertisements as a stand in for paint, exploring the relationship this omnipresent imagery shares with propaganda and indoctrination. In 2013 Bryan completed How to Lose Yourself Completely (The September Issue) which consists of a copy of the September 2007 issue of Vogue Magazine entirely "whited out" with correction fluid. Recently, Bryan's work has begun to explore the act of making art itself as subject matter, along with the traditional systems of value, acceptance and visibility by the art world(s) which to a large degree dictate an artist's career trajectory and financial success. Working largely outside of the commercial art world, his work has evolved considerably over the last 2 decades, always prioritizing the organic development of a clear vision over a simple production line approach. He currently lives and works in Portland, OR.
