- Has ambitious, outrageous ideas that they are willing to scale down and follow through on focuses largely on how to decentralize large scale events through participatory curation
- Is no stranger to guerrilla pop-up techniques in the DIY realm
- Has a lot of experience with risk assessment and terrific judgment when seeking forgiveness or permission
- Is familiar with pacing for the marathon, not the sprint
- Is enthusiastic about brainstorming, networking, event promotion, location scouting, DIY fabrication and/or logistics
- Understands that while some expenses can be reimbursed, there can be no financial compensation for this position—this is what we do for fun
