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Organic Vibrations

I am inspired by organic matter, its vibrating energies glowing and pulsating. Each of these paintings and drawings is made in a single continuous working session using ink and brush on paper or oil paint and brush on canvas. This highly focused, quick-paced method is reminiscent of Chinese ink-and-brush painting. The process of working from observation offers both the experience of visual pleasure as well as a distancing objectification. This notational approach intensifies the markmaking aspect of painting, bringing the subjects' abstract qualities forward.
