*The Bench* set in urban decay and rubble, explores the emotional heartbreak of five homeless characters and the catastrophic hysteria surrounding Aids in the late 1980's. The sparse set is gently integrated with spectacularly beautiful graphic novel projections, from Daphne Arthur's adaptation of the play, and a subdued score designed by composer and writer Deep Singh. It's a fresh and unique blending of 'tour de force' theatre, with graphic novelization, and one performer playing five charged up characters
