Commissioned work can be done on a sliding scale to fit your budget. Smaller/less involved projects can be cheaper, while larger, more time-consuming projects will be more expensive. Once I have an idea of what you want, I can give you a price estimate of what the project could cost. Once we agree on that pricing, we can then arrange a deposit payment via PayPal, Venmo, or Cash App to secure your commission. Deposits will consist of 50% of the estimated price. For example, a \$50 project would require a \$25 deposit. I will try my best to stick to the estimated price but depending on fluctuating material costs final prices may vary. The buyer is responsible for shipping.

Please note that commissioned work can take anywhere from a few weeks to a few months to be ready to ship. Please consider the making time, drying, two separate kiln firings, glazing, as well as any other projects I may be working on. When estimating a price for a project I consider how many hours it will take to complete, how much per hour I would ideally want to make to compensate myself for labor, the cost of materials such as clay, glazes, kiln firings, etc. and the cost of any other specialty materials. Keep in mind that as an artist I have my own style that I work in. Please check out my work on my website, Etsy, or Instagram to make sure that's what you're interested in.

If you can't afford a commission, please reach out and we can work out a payment plan or an exchange of some kind. I love making small things and those tend to be more affordable! I am always willing to work something out with a patron, so just shoot me an email if you have any other questions!!
