## Planer Safety and Operation

- No loose clothing or jewelry. Tie back long hair.
- Wear a face shield and hearing protection.
- 3. Keep fingers 3" from opening (front and back).
- 4. Run Dustkop during use.
- 5. No stock shorter than 24" in length.
- 6. Stand to the side of the machine to avoid kickback or shattering wood.
- 7. Check wood for foreign material. NO NAILS, SCREWS, OR LOOSE KNOTS.
- 8. Set depth before feeding stock.
- 9. A typical pass should remove no more than a 1/16" (a half-turn of the hand wheel).
- Stock 3/8" or thinner may require backer board.
- 11. Some wood may be too warped, twisted, etc. and required cutting or jointing before passing through the planer.
- 12. If wood jams in the machine, slowly crank open the height adjustment until it resumes progress.
