

PRICING AND CLASS POLICIES (August 2019)

Pricing: The class price is \$125 per session. Payment is due the first class of each session and can be in the form of a check made out to Bonnie Paisley or a Venmo transfer to @Bonnie-PaisleyScott. Each session includes 5 regularly scheduled classes, plus one make up opportunity in the 6th week of the session. If you make it to all 5 classes, there is no need to come to the make up session, but you're more than welcome to attend the make up class for a fee of \$25.

Enrollment: Please contact me via email if you would like to sign up for a class. Please specify which class you're interested in. Depending on space, I will confirm your enrollment before the session begins. The sessions are more or less continuous during the year—that is, after the make up class is held, the next session will begin the following week. After each session is over, your space will not be guaranteed in the next session unless you receive verbal or written confirmation from me.

Refunds: No refunds will be allowed once the session begins.

Make up class: The make up class is held on the 6th week of the session, and is available to everyone who is signed up for the session who has missed one of the regularly scheduled classes. The make up class may not be carried over into future sessions.

Materials: I have always tried to provide materials for anyone who is joining the studio classes for the first time. New students will have access to shared oil painting and drawing supplies for their first session. After your first session, you will be encouraged to purchase your own paper, canvases, paint, and drawing materials. I realize that material costs can be a bit of a shock, so please don't hesitate to ask for input from fellow students or from myself before you make large purchases. I am also happy to purchase material's on your behalf as long as I am reimbursed fully during the session in which you're enrolled.

You may store your materials and projects in the designated area while you are enrolled in class. If you discontinue taking classes or take a long break, please take your materials home with you.

Free trial class: During the months of July, August, and December currently enrolled students may bring a friend with you to one regularly scheduled class for free.

Drop-in classes: Drop in classes will occasionally be permissible for established students on a case by case basis, depending on space.

STUDIO ACCESS

The studio is located at 707 NE Broadway #202. Be advised that the studio is not ADA compliant—there is a stair case up to the second floor, but no elevator.

The ground floor entrance to the building is a red door, and it is open to the public. Pull it open and come on up the stairs to #202. Metered parking is available in front of the studio on Broadway and ends at 6pm.

Safety: The studio is located in an urban area, please do not leave any valuables in your car. Please understand that homelessness and mental illness are realities that the city continues to face. Be aware of your surroundings at all times when entering and leaving the studio.
