Artist Statement

My art is about psychological turmoil and its influence on how we experience the world, depicting how personal experiences and intense human conditions alter our perception of reality. Through my work, I argue, reality cannot be reduced to one truthful form, and that the subjective experience is just as real as the visible objective reality. I focus on exploring themes of alienation, displacement, loss, identity and self-representation as a reflection of my unconscious mind.

By working with an interdisciplinary practice in mediums such as photography, printmaking, art installation and video-based art, I investigate the hidden truth within the distorted subjective reality, exploring the obscurities of the human mind and feelings.
