The Dancer Project

"Dancers in Motion" is a collaboration between students in dance and printmaking. This print is composed of 16 individual etching plates of 16 superimposed dance positions performed by George Okokoth and Shamick Otieno and printed in an edition of 16 created primarily by Grace Scott, Melanie Macias, Brook Connolly and Marshall Adams assisted by Lily Jarrell and Heather Muise, printed on BFA cream archival rag paper.
