The Dancer Project

"Dancers in Motion" is a collaboration between students in dance and printmaking. This print is composed of 16 individual etching plates of 16 superimposed dance positions performed by George Okokoth and Shamick Otieno and printed in an edition of 16 created primarily by Grace Scott, Melanie Macias, Brook Connolly and Marshall Adams assisted by Lily Jarrell and Heather Muise, printed on BFA cream archival rag paper. An artist proof of this print hangs in the Dance Center Kenya in Nairobi where George and Shamick began their dance journey as scholarship students from an arts outreach program in the Kibera slums where they grew up. The print edition is intended to raise funds to support Dance Center Kenya students to pursue their education in Greenville.
